SUMMARY OF THE CONGREGATIONAL MEETING HELD FEBRUARY

22ND: Judy Greer was re-elected as an Elder, for a period of 5 years. The 2014 Annual reports were received. A review was made of the 2015 budget. A motion was passed increasing the amount the Ocean Grove Congregation pays to the Parish. The budgeted amount of \$51,000 was increased to \$64,500 for 2015. Church Council had previously approved this increase.
