Homeless children and families in desperate need are being turned away due to reduced funding. #### **HUNGRY FOR CHANGE**

The Ocean Grove JIM Group are promoting the ACT FOR PEACE RATION CHALLENGE. This is to help provide basic food for refugees like those displaced Burmese people in camps in Thailand. This will consist mainly of very small amounts of rice, split peas, a little flour, fish, salt and oil.
